

PRIVACY POLICY NADI AI (nadi.today)

This Policy sets out the general rules for the processing of personal data in connection with the use of the NADI AI Interviewer service, related websites, applications, and interfaces. This Policy is drafted in general terms and does not disclose internal technical solutions where disclosure is not required by law.

By using the Service, the user confirms that they have read this Policy. Where applicable law requires separate consent for specific personal data processing activities, such consent will be requested additionally.

1. Data Controller and Contacts

The data controller is:

2. Categories of Data That May Be Processed

- account and authentication data: name, e-mail address, login identifiers, and information received from authentication providers;
- data required for use of the Service: user content, uploaded files, messages, settings, subscription information, and access status;
- technical data: IP address, device and browser information, login logs, session data, cookies, and similar technologies;
- support request data and other information voluntarily provided by the user to the controller.

If the user, on their own initiative, includes in content information classified by applicable law as special categories of personal data, such information shall be processed only to the extent necessary to provide the Service or on another legal basis provided for by law.

3. Purposes of Processing

- user registration, provision of access to the Service, and performance of the contract;
- authentication, information security, prevention of abuse, and technical support;
- processing of user requests, generation of Service outputs, and display of user content;
- compliance with legal requirements and protection of the controller's rights and legitimate interests;
- improvement of the Service based on anonymized or aggregated data, where permitted by applicable law.

4. Legal Bases for Processing

- entering into and performing a contract with the user;
- the user's consent, where required by applicable law;
- the controller's legitimate interests, provided that such processing does not override the user's rights and freedoms;
- compliance with obligations established by applicable law.

5. Data Storage and Cross-Border Transfer

The controller uses a distributed infrastructure and may engage affiliates, contractors, and technology partners for the storage, transfer, and processing of data to the extent necessary for operation of the Service.

Use of the Service may involve cross-border transfer of personal data where necessary for authentication, hosting, processing of user content, synchronization of data, operation of Service functions, and user support.

By commencing use of the Service, the user consents to such cross-border transfer to the extent necessary for operation of the Service and in accordance with this Policy. Where applicable law requires separate consent, the controller shall request it additionally.

If the user does not agree to the cross-border transfer of data, they must discontinue use of the Service.

6. Provisions for Users Whose Data Is Subject to Localization in the Russian Federation

To the extent that the processing is subject to the requirements of the legislation of the Russian Federation on localization of personal data, collection and other activities for which the law requires the use of databases located within the territory of the Russian Federation shall be carried out using Russian infrastructure.

For users in the Russian Federation, and in other cases where required by the applicable legal framework for processing, the controller may use Yandex technologies for authentication and for placing data within the Russian processing environment. Further processing required for operation of certain Service functions may be carried out outside the Russian Federation in the manner provided for by applicable law and this Policy.

7. Provisions for Users from the Republic of Uzbekistan

The controller ensures compliance with the personal data legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan to the extent applicable to the relevant category of data and the relevant processing method.

8. Disclosure of Data to Third Parties

Data may be disclosed to third parties only where necessary for operation of the Service, performance of the contract, compliance with legal requirements, protection of the controller's rights, or upon the user's instructions. Such parties may include cloud infrastructure providers, authentication providers, and providers of payment, communication, and other technological infrastructure.

9. Retention Periods

Personal data shall be retained no longer than necessary to achieve the purposes of processing, perform the contract, comply with mandatory legal requirements, resolve disputes, handle claims, and protect the controller's rights.

Once the purposes of processing have been achieved, or where there are lawful grounds for deletion, the data shall be deleted or anonymized unless otherwise required by law.

10. User Rights

- to obtain information regarding the processing of their personal data;
- to request rectification, updating, blocking, or deletion of data in the cases provided for by law;
- to withdraw consent to data processing to the extent such processing is based on consent;
- to challenge the controller's actions before the competent authority or a court, where provided for by applicable law.

11. Security

The controller implements legal, organizational, and technical measures aimed at protecting personal data to the extent required by applicable law and taking into account the nature of the data being processed.

12. Cookies and Similar Technologies

The Service may use cookies and similar technologies for authentication, session maintenance, security, saving preferences, and analytics. Restricting the use of cookies may affect the availability of certain Service functions.

13. Amendments to the Policy

The controller may amend this Policy. The current version shall be published in the Service or on the relevant page of the website and shall apply from the date of publication or from any other date specified in the updated version.
